1. Introduction
2. Theoretical Basis and Literature Review
3. Method
4. Results
5. Discussion and Implications
6. Reference List (selection)

Authors are limited to the submission of two abstracts. Please submit the paper as a word-document via e-mail to: michael.forster@htwchur.ch. Include all tables and figures in the document. Documents should not exceed 2MB.

All submissions are reviewed by the IECER Reviewer Board. Evaluation criteria for extended abstracts are:

- Originality of work
- Scientific relevance
- Methodological approach
- Completeness of work
- Clarity in writing
